With great joy and enthusiasm the news was received and spread by the Principal Mrs Clementina Cervale on 19 March 2021 as soon as she read the official letter from Indire National Agency.

The School's International Team, led by the teacher Mrs Ester Mordini (other teachers: Mary Nacca, Rosa Gaeta and Letizia Ricci) achieved a result.

**With a score of 98 out of 100**, "Andrea Argoli" Institute has been classified first in the Province of L'Aquila, second in the Abruzzo Region and among the best 25 schools in Italy.

The project had to match the European quality standards and will make it possible to finance teachers and students high-level training and professional experiences in foreign countries for the next seven years (until 2027) with a consequent growth and learning in languages and European cultures. Students will have the chance of getting in touch with either training and professional realities or innovative and cutting-edge European best practices, which could be useful in future working perspectives.

ERASMUS ACCREDITATION is part of the new Key Action 1 of the Erasmus 2021-2027 Program to support the international mobility of pupils and school staff. So our school will be able to have a simplified path to apply for funding from the Annual call, submitting the budget request to the INDIRE National Agency.
